Through personal dialogues, lectures, and discussions with the invited guests, we will explore innovative approaches for site-analysis as an important step toward developing distinct design languages. In small groups, students will introduce the guests and moderate the dialogue in the round table discussions. For the final project, each student will use visual and textual mediums to develop a creative portrait of a guest that responds directly to their projects and methods. Additionally, students will have the opportunity to do their own creative site-reading in a day-long workshop in Zurich.
